Here you can find an interactive map which will show your nearest local recycling centre and authorised collection point for WEEE and battery recycling. What happens to your waste?

Where can I recycle waste batteries?

Recycling WEEE and waste batteries is free. You can bring them to your local recycling centre or civic amenity site. You just drop them into the right box. The vEMC pays for the WEEE to be collected and recycled safely. Find the recycling centre nearest to you, where you can recycle your WEEE, batteries, and light bulbs.

Can used batteries be recycled?

Many garages and car dealerships also accept used batteries for recycling. Benefits of Recycling: Recycling lead-acid batteries prevents toxic chemicals from entering the environment and ensures valuable materials like lead are reused. Electric vehicle (EV) batteries are typically lithium-ion batteries on a much larger scale.

Where can I recycle a lithium ion battery?

Where to Recycle: Drop off lithium-ion batteries at designated recycling points or return them to partnering retailers participating in WEE. For larger quantities, specialised recycling centres handle this type of battery. Car batteries, typically lead-acid batteries, are used in most vehicles to power electrical systems and start engines.
