

## How high is the solar light bracket at the front door

When placing solar front door lights, it's essential to consider both security and aesthetic appeal. Fixtures should be positioned to illuminate key areas such as doorways, pathways, and steps to ...

If you're hanging lights on both sides of the door, hang them about one-quarter the height of the door. However, don't hang lights lower than about 6 feet from the ground.

For one light: Center it about 66-72 inches from the ground to the center of the fixture. For two lights: Mount each light so the center is roughly 66 inches above the porch floor.

When hanging one light near an entry the light should be about 1/3 the height of the door. When hanging two lights near an entry the lights should be about 1/4 the height of the door.

Keep in mind that outdoor porch lights or wall lights work best when placed above shoulder height to keep direct light out of your eyes (5.5" - 6"), and help with tasks, like unlocking your door.

For entryways and front doors, mount lights so the center of the fixture is 66 to 72 inches above the ground. This height offers enough illumination for activities like finding keys or greeting guests while ...

This places fixtures at between 3/4 and 7/8 of the height of the door and lets those approaching the door knock or gain entry without glare in their eyes. Lights need to be high enough ...
