

How to introduce outdoor ground wire into base station

Grounding is not optional -- it's required by the National Electrical Code (NEC) and is one of the most important safety systems in any home or building. The goal of electrical panel grounding ...

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A ground rod would be driven into the ground within a couple feet of the base of the mast. A heavy copper wire (#6 AWG) or larger would be used to interconnect the mast to this ground rod.

The ground lug on your transceiver is provided so that the operator can ground the case, which is usually also connected to the shield of the coaxial cable, to an RF ground.

Placing an 8' ground rod into the ground directly below the antenna is recommended for a base station. Then, run a #8 solid copper ground wire from the U-Clamp, attaching the antenna to the mast.

Locate the ground bus bar inside the panel. It is usually green or bare metal and connects directly to a grounding electrode. Attach your ground wire securely to the bus bar using a screw, ...

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
