

Is there any solar power station in Mauritania

The project will provide rural electrification for 40 localities in south-eastern Mauritania, through the installation of hybrid mini photovoltaic power plants and the construction of connecting lines.

The project includes a 160 MW photovoltaic solar plant in Nouakchott, a 60 MW wind farm in Boulenouar, and a 370 MWh battery storage system to ensure grid stability.
